Pallbearers are Don Adkins, Rick Adkins, Eric Adkins, Billy Adkins, Randy Atkins, and Sammy Atkins.

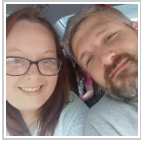

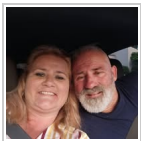
